**South River Technologies Announces FIPS Certification for
Titan MFT Server**

The new release includes FIPS Certification, improved localization capability and support for SRT's new web interface.

Compliance with FIPS, the Federal Information Processing Standards developed by the National Institute of Standards and Technology for U.S. government computer systems is a critical requirement for government customers. FIPS is designed to help ensure the security of information stored in disparate systems. SRT has a substantial base of customers at all levels of government, and compliance with FIPS will enable increased adoption by federal agencies.

“Today there’s a mandate from businesses, government agencies and universities about securing confidential information,” said Michael Ryan, co-founder and CEO of South River Technologies. “Titan MFT Server is appealing to these organizations because it works with existing IT infrastructures to very quickly and cost-effectively secure information. Alternatives like VPNs can be expensive to set up and maintain and create challenges for working with external trading partners.”

[Titan MFT Server](#) encrypts files during transmission and supports encrypted file storage. Once files are received by Titan MFT Server, the product’s automation capability can launch processes, initiate files into workflow systems or generate notifications. Titan MFT Server facilitates high-volume implementations by supporting clustering and load balancing. With granular security settings and support for multiple file transfer protocols and authentication technologies, Titan MFT gives the IT or security administrator the desired degree of control. When used with SRT’s [DMZedge Server](#), Titan MFT Server further secures network communication by reducing the risk of network intrusion.
